There will be a **waiting room** on the screen. A **staff member** will **let me in!**







Please wait, the meeting host will let you in soon.

A guardian will help make sure my microphone is off and my video is on.






I can also turn my video off if I want to!

Ushers wear red shirts. These people can help me during the performance.






USHER

Time Period - in classical music, this is referring to when the music was written and often gives clues to its characteristics

Pizzicato - plucking of strings rather than using the bow

During the performance I will be **asked** to **clap** to the rhythm.



I will **listen** to their instructions in the class. It will be really **fun!**

QUIET TIME

I should keep my **microphone off** while Parker Quartet is talking. It makes people **happy** when I am quiet and listening.





QUIET TIME

It's okay if I **forget** to turn my off my microphone!

An **usher** will turn it off for me.





LOUD

Clapping can be loud.

My computer can make loud noises.





NOISY

I can cover my ears if it is loud.



NOISY

My guardian can also help me **lower the volume** of the computer.




SING ALONG

I may be asked to **sing along** with **Parker Quartet**. It is **fun** to **sing along**!










BREAK

END OF SHOW


People will **ask questions** at the end

questions.




END OF SHOW
